Description	This course is mainly intended for Master students who chose the specialisations "Droit du contentieux" and "Droit international et comparé".
	It provides the students with an in-depth analysis of the rules on international commercial litigation before State courts. Based on cases and practical examples, it adopts a transnational and comparative approach to core litigation issues (such as international jurisdiction, lis pendens, forum non conveniens, anti-suit injuctions, class and group actions, international cooperation in civil and commercial matters, recognition and enforcement of judgments). In a first part, students will learn to apply the Lugano Convention and Brussels I bis Regulation. In a second part they will get an overview of US and English litigation rules. The course will be taught in English.
