Gender equality grant Individual and flexible support for young women scientists	<ul> <li>Employment as a woman researcher at doctoral or postdoctoral level in an SNSF-funded project, or female grantee of an SNSF career funding scheme (see guidelines for exceptions)</li> <li>A work-time percentage of at least 60%, funded by the SNSF</li> <li>For researchers at universities of applied sciences, a doctorate is not mandatory</li> </ul>	The gender equality grant belongs to the category of eligible costs and is covered by a deficit guarantee. You do not need to submit a separate application. <b>Flexibility Grant</b> Be a scientist AND a parent	<ul> <li>Employment as a doctoral student or postdoc in a research project funded by the SNSF or grantee of an SNSF career funding scheme (Ambizione, PRIMA and Doc.CH)</li> <li>A work-time percentage of at least 80%, funded by the SNSF</li> <li>Main carer or providing at least half of the child care (till the end of primary school)</li> </ul>	Applications need to be submitted via the digital platform mySNF, at least four months before the end of the project. Payment of grants starts two months after submission of the appli- cation at the earliest.	<ul> <li>Two grant options:</li> <li>Child care costs: contribution towards child care costs (per child up to CHF 1,000 per month)</li> <li>Only for postdocs</li> <li>Support person: contribution towards the salary of a scientific, technical or student support person. This allows for a work-time reduction down to a minimum work percentage of 60%. Mobility grants in projects Gain more research experience by going abroad!	<ul> <li>Employment as a doctoral student working for a research project funded by the SNSF</li> <li>Stay at a research institution abroad of between 6 and 12 months</li> <li>Stay abroad is supported by project leader and host institution</li> </ul>	Applications can be submitted via the digital platform mySNF while the project is ongoing; at least eight months before the end of the project and two months before the start of the stay abroad.	<ul> <li>Funding: travel and living costs as well as conference and workshop fees of up to CHF 20,000.</li> <li>Additional funding: higher amounts are available if family members (partner, children) travel with grantee</li> </ul>	SNSF division dealing with main grant
