DIRECTIVE FROM THE DEAN'S OFFICE FOR THE GRANTING OF A SUBSIDY FOR SCIENTIFIC EVENTS ORGANISED BY THE FBM WITH AT LEAST 50% FEMALE SPEAKERS

Approved by the Dean's Office on December 21st, 2022

The Dean's office of the Faculty of Biology and Medicine (FBM) referring to the following acts (in French):

adopts the following directive:

Art. 1 Principle of the Directive

A subsidy is granted by the Dean's Office of the FBM to departments, schools, associations, representatives of the different faculty bodies and to departments and services of the CHUV and Unisanté which organize a scientific event (defined in art.2) with a minimum of 50% women§ among all scheduled speakers.

Art. 2 Events that can benefit from the subsidy

- 1 Scientific events are defined as scientific meetings that are deemed to be of significant
 - a. relevance to research in medicine and/or biology by the Dean's Office of the FBM
 - b. (proof of relevance is requested in the attached form).
- 2 The events that may be subsidised are forums, departmental or interdepartmental
 - a. seminar days, symposia, and conference cycles or days:
 - b. which present a programme including a minimum of 6 scheduled speakers
 - c. which are organised by one or more departments, schools, associations, or services of the FBM including the CHUV or Unisanté.
 - d. which take place on the UNIL, CHUV or Unisanté sites.
- 3 Events already benefiting from a UNIL subsidy, such as a CUSO grant, are not eligible.
- In the case of an event that is not eligible for the reasons given in point 3, the Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Commission (EDI) may decide to support an event that is deemed to demonstrate a specific investment in equality, up to a maximum of four events per year, each to the amount of Frs. 500 each. This grant is exceptional and non-cumulative.

ANNEXE: DIRECTIVE FROM THE DEAN'S OFFICE FOR THE GRANTING OF A SUBSIDY FOR SCIENTIFIC EVENTS ORGANISED BY THE FBM AND THE CHUV WITH AT LEAST 50% FEMALE SPEAKERS

Art. 3 Conditions for granting the subsidy

- The event must include at least 50% of scheduled female[§] speakers who present a topic related to medical and/or biological research.
- In the case of cycles of events over a given period, the application must be made for the entire programme and not for each day of the conference.
- Any grant awarded must be clearly indicated in the announcements of the scientific event, displaying the logo of the Equality, Diversity, and Inclusion Commission (EDI) on the supported initiative.

Art. 4 Amount of the subsidy

The amount of the subsidy shall be a maximum of CHF 5,000, in proportion to the number of scheduled speakers (see form in annexe for the amounts available).

Art. 5 Procedure

- The organising body shall submit a written (electronically typed) request at least one month before the event or the start of the programme, using the attached form. The documents should be sent in one PDF file to: egalite-fbm@unil.ch
- 2 The amount will be paid to the organising body once the event has taken place.
- A brief report indicating the number of participants, any feedback received, any information in relation to EDI and the final budget should be sent, in one PDF file no later than one month after the event to: egalite-fbm@unil.ch. The report is subsequently presented to the Dean's office.

Art. 6 Entry into force

This Directive shall enter into force on December 21st, 2022
