- the master's thesis is considered as a course/exam: please sign up if you think you will present your thesis between now and February 6, 2023

- warning : your registration on Moodle is not equivalent to a course/exam registration
- if you need special arrangements for medical reasons, please refer to this [document](#) and send us a valid medical certificate by October 16 at the very latest
