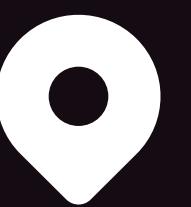
ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The conference will address the evolution of data protection law from a right to privacy to a right to data protection, the legal obligations falling on businesses, and the role of the law and technologies in protecting individuals. The conference will analyse the future of data protection laws looking at their efficiency in protecting individuals' privacy today and assessing the urgency to adopt other regulations to protect individuals from harmful technologies.
