SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE FOUNDATION SOPHIE AFENDULI

Sophie Afenduli Foundation, whose head office is in Lausanne, the main purpose of the Foundation is assigning one or more scholarship(s) to support full or partial costs of higher education (university, polytechnic-school or other equivalent schools) or training for research students or Greek researchers in Switzerland or Swiss students or researchers in one area of Greece (Article 3.1 of the Statute).

The minimum education level of scholarship applicant is the master.

Statuts (extraits):

- Art. 4.1 Applicants (see 3.1 above) are deserving students or researchers. They must submit to the Foundation a written, reasoned and accompanied by all documents supporting their academic and personal, a curriculum vitae and a description of the project for which they seek support from the Foundation. They also indicate whether they have solicited and / or received support from other public or private organizations, and, if so, the amount and duration of this support.
- Art. 4.2 The funding of a period of study or research shall not exceed the usual duration of it, barring exceptional circumstances. In addition, the renewal of the scholarship takes place only upon presentation of a fully satisfactory report to institution in which studies are conducted or searches.
- Art. 4.3 A grant may be removed by the Foundation Board in cases of abuse, cheating or any evidence to justify removal.
- Art. 4.4 The decision to award or withdrawal is without recourse or appeal.
- Art. 4.5 The beneficiaries shall not be entitled to any non-public information about the Foundation.

Documents to be submitted by the candidate:

- Application Form completed and signed (available from the Secretariat of the Foundation);
- Note on a page written in French or English explaining clearly your goals;
- Curriculum vitae in English or French;
- Certificates of studies and transcript (legalized translations in French or English);
- Two letters of recommendation a minimum, in English or French;
- Certification of a professor with whom the candidate is related to his work;
- Identity document certifying nationality (photocopy);
- Student ID or registration or certificate of the employer, if applicable;
- Detailed budget.

As a rule, applications for grants must reach the Foundation by March 31 for the next academic year.

Scholarships may be renewed under certain conditions. Any application for renewal must be accompanied by a report on work done during the period, and a report of the professor who supervises.
